One day workshop for year 11 & 12 Visual Arts students are held during the April school holidays. - 9.30 – 9.45 **Registration**
Meet at the Administration entrance: 47 James Street, near the Museum.
- 9.45 – 11.00 **Requirements for and presentation of a visual diary: Session A**
A selection of TEE visual diaries from 2008 will be available for perusal. This session will allow students to discuss the work of others and the requirements of an outstanding visual diary.
- 11.00 – 11.15 **Refreshments**
- 11.15 – 12.30 **Requirements for and presentation of a visual diary: Session B**
This session will provide participants with a further opportunity to closely analyse the 2008 visual diaries. Emphasis will be placed upon the five criteria of visual diary assessment.
- 12.30 – 1.15 **Lunch**
- 1.15 – 3.30 **Investigation of students' own visual diaries: your visual diary**
The final session will provide participants with an opportunity to share ideas and gain feedback about their own visual diaries, through small group sessions with peers and an Education Officer. This will help highlight areas of strength and weakness. Gallery resources will also be made available for students to research interrelationships as well as enhance skills in visual literacy/arts language.
