Who can enter:

3 categories **PRIMARY**, **SECONDARY** and **TERTIARY** students.

How to enter:

Design and construct your entry. Photograph your entry (maximum of 3 photos). Complete your entry form and mail together with your images to: **Design Challenge c/- P. Lowe, Art Gallery of Western Australia, PO Box 8363, Perth Business Centre, Perth WA 6849.**

Design Challenge Dates:

Entries: close **Monday 25 May 10am.**

Judging: Tuesday 26 May.

Delivery of Designs: Thursday 28, Friday 29 May, Roe St entrance, (opposite the Perth Train Station) 8.30am-5.00pm.

Display Dates: Monday 8 June - Sunday 5 July.

Opening Ceremony and presentations: Monday 8 June 4.00pm.

Judging: A selected panel of designers will choose the **2** most successful entries from **each** category. These three dimensional designs will be displayed in the Art Gallery of Western Australia.

Prize Draw: **All** entries are eligible to enter the prize draw for their category.

Prizes

Primary Age Group- Art Supplies Pack valued at \$100, plus a \$50 book voucher for the School.

Secondary Age Group- IPOD 16GB Nano **or** Art Gallery gift shop voucher valued at \$300.

Tertiary Age Group- IPOD 16GB Nano **or** Art Gallery gift shop voucher valued at \$300.

Design Challenge Briefs

Primary

Design a functional chair / seat suitable for 1 adult. Your design must be inspired by the natural world. You also need to make your design sustainable and where possible incorporate recycled materials. **Note** your design does **not** have to be to scale. Minimum size is 30cm x 30cm x 30cm.

Secondary

Design a functional chair / seat suitable for 1 adult. Your design can be inspired from a variety of sources e.g. the natural world (this can include microscopic forms), Mathematics, Art Movements, Technology and Science. You can choose to make your design sustainable and incorporate recycled materials. Your design does **not** have to be to scale. Minimum size is 40cm x 40cm x 40cm. Maximum size is to scale.

Tertiary

Design a functional chair / seat suitable for 1 or 2 adults. Your design can be inspired from a variety of sources, should stimulate the senses and provoke thought in the way we use and engage with objects. You can choose to make your design sustainable and incorporate recycled materials. The chair / seat should either be to scale or a minimum size of 70cm x 70cm x 70cm, and be designed for the commercial market.

Judging Criteria

- aesthetics
- originality
- ergonomics
- function / practicality
- structure
- commercial viability (Tertiary students)

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Work submitted must have been completed during the year of entry (2009).
2. It will not be possible to access works for any purpose, whilst they are on site at the Art Gallery of Western Australia.
3. Work submitted must be in accordance with the following standards:
 - Each **entry form** must include up to **3 x A4 colour high quality images** of the finished design, with name and category printed on the reverse side.
 - All works must be well constructed for display and travelling purposes. **Sound construction of artwork is the responsibility of the artist and not the Art Gallery of Western Australia.**
 - Works must be able to be displayed as they are.
 - If a work comprises several components, if selected, directions for construction must be supplied.

4. The judging panel is responsible for selecting works for exhibition at the Art Gallery of Western Australia. Their decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
5. The Art Gallery of Western Australia reserves the right to display works as they see appropriate and no correspondence will be entered into regarding placement of individual works.
6. Entrants agree that their images of artwork can be reproduced either in whole or detail by the Art Gallery of Western Australia for educational purposes, for advertising and promotional purposes, in the media, on the Art Gallery of Western Australia website, for posters and signage.
7. The Art Gallery of Western Australia reserves the right to cancel or alter published dates for exhibition.
8. The Art Gallery of Western Australia has high standards of security and all due care and attention will be taken with the artworks submitted. However, the Gallery accepts no responsibility or liability for loss or damage to artworks during drop-off, collection, storage and exhibition.
9. Selected works **must** be collected from Roe St by 5pm, Tuesday 7 July, 2009.
